

**CITY OF SHEPHERDSVILLE
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 22nd 2022
6:30 PM**

CALL TO ORDER

With an invocation by Councilwoman Bonnie Enlow, and the recital of the Pledge of Allegiance, Mayor Hockenbury called the meeting to order at 6:30PM.

ROLL CALL

Present: Lisa Carter, Bonnie Enlow, Mike Hibbard, Deb Huffman, and Kenny Newton. Stacey Cline was absent.

ANNOUNCEMENT

Mayor Hockenbury announced that the November 28th, 2022 Regular Council Meeting would be cancelled for the holidays.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Tammy Baker was to perform the second reading of Ordinance 022-076 an Ordinance amending the Bullitt County/City Zoning map as amended, changing the zoning of 7.737 Acres, more or less, located at 1132 Forest Hill Rd. in the City of Shepherdsville, Kentucky, also known as Parcel 037-000-00-055A from Agricultural to R-1 Residential.

Bonnie Enlow stated that she wanted to table this rezone until the meeting on December 12th because they had received a complaint they wanted to verify whether it was true or not prior to passing the ordinance.

NEW BUSINESS

The single bid that the Fire Department received to build the new Multi-Purpose Building was opened and read. The bid was submitted by James Jewell Custom Homes for \$85,900.00.

The council asked different questions about what it included, such as doors etc. Copies were made for the council so they could review it before voting.

Chief Layne Troutman explained that \$65,000.00 dollars of this amount was going to be paid for by grant money they had received for this project and the remaining amount would be paid for by money in the Assets Purchase Line Item of their budget.

Captain Pruitt also answered several questions they had.




