Failure to pay this fine may result in a lien being placed against the property.

Notice of Right to Appeal

Once the City provides notice in accordance with § 31.27(F), a lienholder may have the ability to avoid having a lien placed on the property by paying the civil fine on behalf of the property owner, or abating the nuisance, within forty-five (45) days from when the document is available on the City's database.
