CITY ATTORNEY KATHERINE DOZIER READ RESOLUTION **024-001** AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO OPEN A NEW BANK ACCOUNT AT WEBANCO AS A POLICE DEPARTMENT NON-INTEREST-BEARING ACCOUNT.

Mike Hibbard asked what this account was for.

Chief Schmidt said the need for this account is for any money received that is pending the outcome in court.

Mike Hibbard asked him if it is basically for funds that are being held until the judge decides what to do with it.

Chief Schmidt told him yes and it could be used in multiple circumstances such as if someone found money and turned it over to the PD or money from a drug case.

Mayor Cubero said it is a good idea to have it because there will be records kept on the funds received.

Brad Whittaker asked if there was a possibility the money could be forfeited to the PD.

Chief Schmidt told him that was correct, and they would have to pay a percentage (10-15%) to the Commonwealth and/or the County Attorney's Office.




